

## Alarm By-Law Approved Registration Fee Waived for the Month of October

Chief Jim Hurley of the Leicester Police Department, Chief Robert Wilson of the Leicester Fire Department and the Leicester Board of Selectmen announced that the Town of Leicester's Alarm By-Law has been approved by the Massachusetts Attorney General's Office and is ready to be implemented. The by-law requires that all commercial and residential burglary and fire alarms be registered with the Leicester Police Department. The by-law also contains a penalty for numerous false alarms. The Police Chief and the Fire Chief along with the Board of Selectmen have waived the alarm registration fee for alarm registrations received during the month of October 2007. Completed registration forms should be forwarded to the:
